- 2. Culinary experience. Explain your qualifications and passion for cooking and the ability to plan and perform events for senior leaders such as experience, training, and/or any other functions/events that will highlight your culinary skills; what's special, unique, distinctive, and/or impressive about you and your military career.
- 3. What details of your personal, professional, history, people and/or events have shaped you or influenced your goals that might help the selection and nomination panel better understand you or help set you apart from other applicants?
