DEFINITION

The Tactical Field Readiness Training Center (TFRTC) incorporates the Army Chief of Staff's priorities that supports the Army Warfighting concept over a ten-day lesson plan comprised of critical Field Feeding task. The TFRTC will increase the readiness of field feeding systems (personnel and equipment) with deliberate emphasis on "battle drill" training focused on the individual and supervisory skill levels. Training objectives will be nested with individual and collective tasks required to support the Warfighter during Large Scale Combat Operations.

IMPERATIVES

- Ensure full certification of Tactical Feeding Specialists (92Gs) for wartime readiness.
- Provide realistic, scenario-based training to simulate LSCO conditions.
- Maintain the highest standards of field feeding proficiency and safety.
- Support readiness by continuously updating training based on evolving operational needs.

OUTCOME

- Certified 92G Feeding Specialists capable of executing field feeding tasks efficiently.
- Enhanced operational readiness and confidence among Tactical Feeding teams.
- Improved field feeding techniques aligned with current military standards.
- Strengthened logistical support for large-scale combat operations.

MISSION

Develop and sustain the readiness of 92G Field Feeding proficiency that will enable 92Gs to employ Field Feeding capabilities across any future operational environment with speed in support of Large-Scale Combat Operations.

92G Mission Essential Tasks

TOE: 10450P000

Mission: Provides field feeding to Army Echelons Above Brigade (EAB) operating forces. This company plans, manages, supervises, and administers field feeding operations by deploying on demand with customer organizations as required. Receive requests for field feeding support and allocates field feeding assets according to type of support and level of demand, plans and coordinates with logistics commands, provides internal administrative and maintenance functions.
